



## What is U3A?

U3A, is a world-wide movement that provides exciting opportunities for retired and semi-retired people to meet people with similar interests, to learn and engage in stimulating discussions.

It is a university in the sense of people coming together to share knowledge.

In New Zealand each branch is independent.

## How does it work?

U3A Bay of Islands is a friendly organization. Small interest groups meet during daylight hours, usually in members' homes.

These groups use the experience, expertise and knowledge of our members. Members may act as facilitators or hosts, although this is not required.

There are no compulsory activities and no examinations. There are no entry qualifications other than a desire to participate in a stimulating environment.

Each year we hold five general meetings with interesting speakers and a chance to meet other members.
